

Installation Instructions for Touring Tools Demo Products from A Bridge Solution

*** Important ***

Do not, under any circumstances, modify file names. If you do, these Demos will not work.

*** Important ***

Before running the applications, we strongly suggest that you download, print/read the feature files so you know in advance what the various applications, utilities and shared files can do for you. It will lessen the learning curve greatly!

Once you have installed one application and you later decide to install another, **you DO NOT have to install the Engine, Engine Support System files, Shared, Utilities or All Need files again!** Simply download the application file or if installing from CD ROM, double click on the file within the CD ROM.

Installation Instructions *** Please Follow The Instructions Carefully***

Getting files to your computer:

1. Download the appropriate compressed files to your Desktop.
2. Quit all running applications
3. Decompress the files by:

For Mac: Make sure that you have downloaded all the necessary files for your operating system and the ABS Product!

1. Make sure that you have **Aladdin Expander Version 5** installed on your computer. (Files were compressed using **Aladdin Drop Stuff and WinZip Self Extractor**)
2. <http://www.aladdinsys.com/download.expander.html> go here to download, if not already installed on your computer.
3. The next step is to configure Expander by double clicking on its icon, make sure that Expander is the active application, then... on the top title bar select file, then preferences. Now you will see various preference categories, choose destination, that gives you two subcategories... make sure that the following are checked
 - a. destination: check "Ask"
 - b. Create surrounding folder: check "Never"
 - c. Choose "OK", you are done with this preference category
1. Next, choose the internet config preference category on the left. You will see multiple boxes checked
 - d. Make sure ZIP/GZIP IS CHECKED, if it is not, do so
 - e. Choose "OK", you are now done configuring Expander
1. Create a **New Folder and name it ABS Demo**. **This will be your root folder** and it is here that you will place the contents of the category folders.
2. Drag and drop each file on to your **Aladdin Expander** Icon. (Actually, if you double click on each file it should automatically decompress, if not, drop it on the Expander icon).
3. If you have configured Expander correctly, you will now be asked to select the destination folder (if you are not asked to select a destination folder, stop what you are doing and go back and configure Expander properly).
4. If you have configured Expander correctly, highlight ABS Demo folder by single clicking on it, then press the bottom button that SHOULD SAY: select "ABS Demo"
5. Repeat this process on all the files you downloaded
6. Lets review: The Root Folder is: ABS Demo, inside the root folder will be the files, the system folder and abs_art folder.
7. Verify that all files and folders are where they should be *** (see folder chart at the end) ***
8. If you don't want this demo to reside on your desktop, you can now move it
9. If you move it, we suggest that you create an alias (on your desktop) to the **FILE ABS Demo**

10. You are now ready to run the demo. Do so by double clicking on **the file or alias ABS Demo** (this will always be your startup file)

For Windows: Make sure that you have downloaded all the necessary files for your operating system and the ABS Demo!

1. Once you have downloaded all the appropriate, they should now be on your desktop
2. **Please Note: Windows 95/98/2000 has a preference setting that can hide the file extensions. If you have this preference set, you will not see the file extensions and file names such as system.exe will appear as system**
3. Double click on system.exe. It will self extract and create a folder named ABS_Demo on your desktop. Inside will be a folder named system.
4. Then, double click on each of the remaining files. This will automatically decompress them and place their contents in the ABS_Demo folder.
5. Lets review: The Root Folder is: ABS Demo, inside the root folder will be the files, the system folder and abs_art folder.
6. Verify that all files and folders are where they should be *** (see folder chart at the end) ***
7. If you don't want this demo to reside on your desktop, you can move it, now
8. If you move it, we suggest that you create a short cut (on your desktop) to the file **ABS_Demo.exe**
9. If all folder/file structure has been verified and you have installed **Win32s 1.30c** if using Windows 3.1/11 or NT 3.51
10. You are now ready to run the demo. Do so by double clicking on the **file or short cut ABS_Demo.exe** (this is always your startup file)! **Again, if you are not already familiar with these applications, please read the feature files.**

If you are running Windows 3.1 or Windows for Workgroups 3.11 or Windows NT 3.51, you must place also the **4winsys folder and its contents within the ABS Demo folder**. It contains files that are necessary for the "3-D" look and feel. When the ABS Demo is first opened, the appropriate files will be copied to the \Windows\System folder, and the 4winsys folder will be deleted. If you place it in the ABS Demo folder and you are running Windows 95, Windows 98, or Windows NT 4.0 or later, the 4winsys folder is unnecessary and is automatically deleted the first time you run the ABS Demo.

End users running Windows 3.1 **must install** Win32s version 1.30c **before** running the ABS Demo. For more information on Win32s, see "Installing Win32s" below.

Installing Win32s

To run solution files on Windows 3.1 and Windows for Workgroups 3.11, you must first install Win32s 1.30c. Disk copies of Win32s 1.30c are available for download separately.

Creating Win32s diskettes

To create Win32s diskettes:

1. Format three 1.44 MB diskettes and name them Disk1, Disk2 and Disk3.
2. Drag the contents of the corresponding folders (after downloading and uncompressing) onto the floppy disks.

IMPORTANT Disk names, filenames and paths cannot be modified or the Win32s installation will fail.

To install 32s:

1. Open the 386 Enhanced control panel and change the virtual memory type to PERMANENT.
2. Make sure the swap file size is at least 20480 KB.
3. Select Use 32-Bit Disk Access and Use 32-Bit File Access, if available.

If any changes were made, you'll need to restart Windows before installing Win32s.

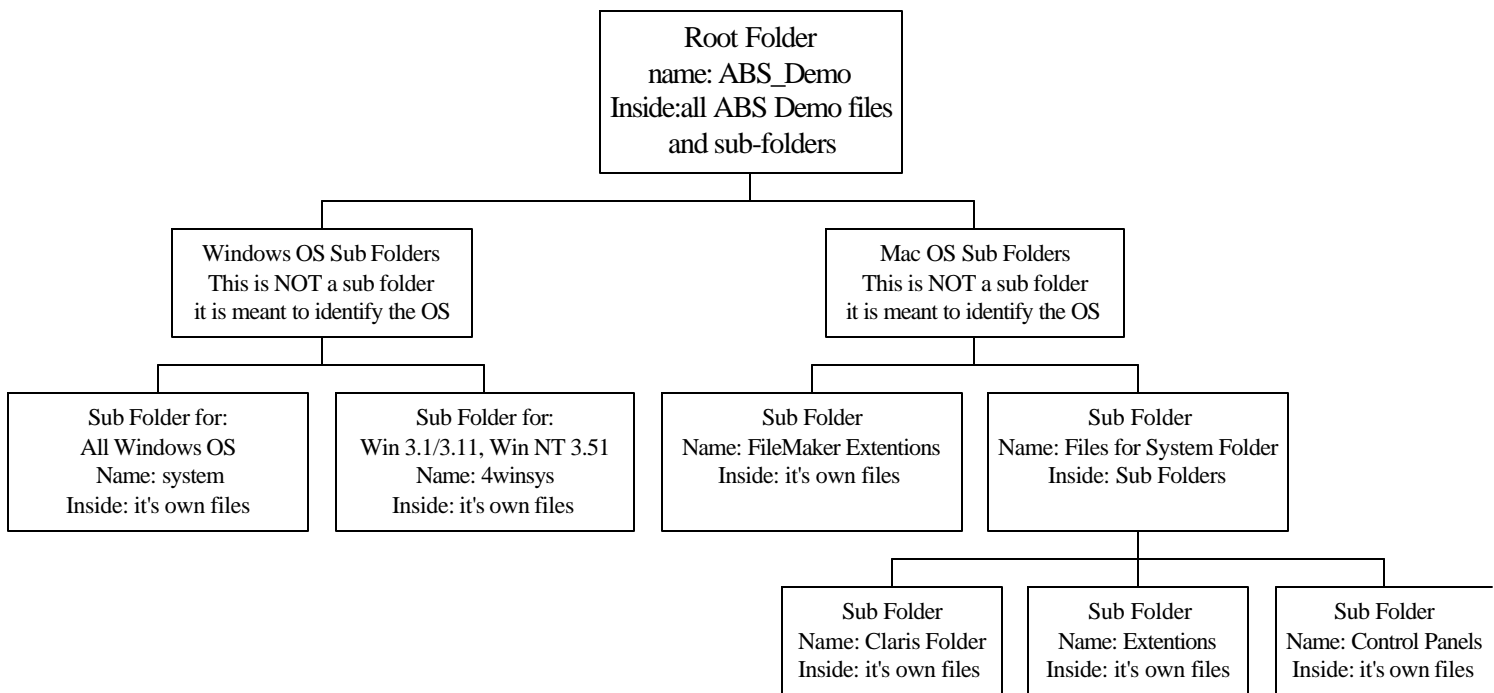
4. Install Win32s: Insert the Win32s Disk1. In the program Manager, choose RUN from the file menu and type a:\setup.exe from the Program Manager. Follow the Win32s setup instructions.
5. When the Win32s installation is complete, the FreeCell Setup dialog box appears.

We recommend that you verify that the Win32s software has been installed correctly, by installing the game FreeCell, included with Win32s version 1.30c.

6. Restart the machine before installing the bundled solution.
7. Make sure the 4winsys folder is in the solution folder on the hard disk after the solution has been installed.

When installing a runtime solution on a computer with Windows 3.1, Windows NT 3.51 or Windows for Workgroups 3.11, be sure to include the 4winsys folder. This folder contains DLLs that the runtime application needs to display the application interface elements correctly.

- **If you have downloaded a Full Version of an ABS Demo such as TourPro, LaborPro, LiveNotes, etc. or downloaded a stand-alone Module such as GuestList or ShowTally:.**
 1. **Choose the Setup call button and proceed with Setup. (You can bypass this step if you want but at least check it out so you know what it does)**
 2. **Choose the Utility call button to see all the bonus features.**
 3. **Choose the go to demos call button and then choose the call button for the ABS Demo you have installed.**

1. Regarding Help Files and Tech Support

- **FileMaker Pro Help files have been included with the Demos**
 - **Mac: no call button has been provided; you must double click the help file itself (sorry, its a Mac scripting issue and is being dealt with)**
 - **Windows: a call button within the demo calls the help file**
